The Community Health Advisory Team (formerly the Reopening Task Force) has met infrequently in the last six months as Covid transmission has slowed and testing and vaccines have become widely available. With a return to cooler weather and indoor activities, and hopefully larger gatherings at church, we encourage members of our congregation to follow CDC guidance and use common sense when it comes to masking or staying home if ill. Our staff will be testing frequently, and the Minister tests for Covid twice a week and always on Saturdays.
